In this book, there are 30 designs which of of a variety of different characters. Some are cute little fairies while others are sweet little girls (some even appear to be toddlers.) There are

seasonal girls and even a Mary Had A Little Lamb girl. What the characters all have in common is the sweet expressions and large eyes that are the signature of this artist. I really enjoy coloring this style of design – it makes for a fun and quick project. I sometimes find that when I am working on something that takes days to finish, it makes sense to stop and do something fun that I can finalize in an hour or two. This is what I found while testing and coloring this book: 30 Big Eyed Girls and Fairies the Lacy Sunshine line. Printed on one side of page. Paper is typical CreateSpace – thin, white, slightly rough and non-perforated. Glue Bound Designs stop before the binding area. Alcohol and water-based bleed through the page. I suggest the use of a blotter page below your working page. Gel pens and India ink pens leave colorful shadows on the back of the page. Coloring pencils work well – both wax and oil based pencils put down good color, layer and blend well. Hard lead pencils dent the back of the page. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. If you love the wide-eye kids you're probably going to love it, too. To me, coloring the pages in Lacy Sunshine's "The Boo's" Coloring Book Volume 3: Whimsical Big Eyed Girls and Fairies by Heather Valentin is like drifting into a wonderful childhood. The faces of these little girls and fairies are so expressive I just melt into them. They are also very easy for me to color. Most of the spaces are large and allow me room to blend, add color, add more definition all while enjoying the experience. I love coloring and currently have about 40 different books but I keep going back to this book and so does my daughter, daughter-in-law and granddaughter. When everyone is here, we do rock/paper/scissors to see who gets to color a page in this book. Aside from the darling pictures, the pages in the coloring book are easy to color. We can use one or a combination of colored pencils, gel pens, markers or paint markers and it seldom bleeds through. However even knowing that, I always insist no matter which book we use that we place a plain sheet of white computer paper behind our coloring page for that "just in case" moment. The only thing I wish is that it had the serrated pages so I could tear the pages out easily. However I have started using an ExactO knife to cut them out so I can share more than one page from the book at a time with others when they come to color. I am positive that as soon as I color a few more pages in a few more books that I will be buying more from this artist. I'm posting one that my 16 year old granddaughter colored but was ashamed of it. She used regular colored pencils and watercolor pencils and brushes. The lips were a mistake. She painted them with watercolor pencils and when she added water, the lips smeared. However as I believe that there is NO mistake in art but that it's an opportunity to become creative, we all decided that this little girl had ice cream on her mouth. Now, it's one of her favorites. Although I am a product tester/reviewer and am fortunate to receive many products at a discount (or sometimes free) in exchange for my HONEST and UNBIASED opinion, this was a product purchase that I made at the same full price anyone could have purchased it. Either way, it doesn't make any difference because I ALWAYS pretest every product prior to writing a review. I am free to write whatever I believe to be true, whether negative or positive. This is my true story and my honest opinion.
